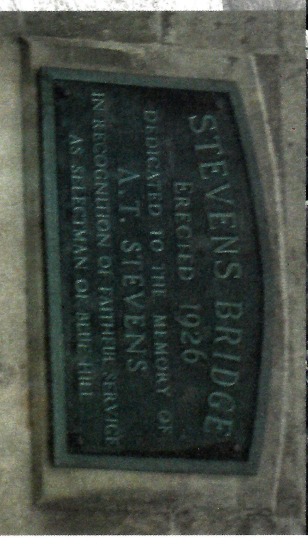


Informational Public Meeting to Discuss Alternatives for the Falls Bridge

The Falls Bridge (Stevens

Bridge) is a historic, concrete tied-arch structure built in 1926 that carries Falls Bridge Road (Route 175) over the outlet of Salt Pond between Blue Hill and South Blue Hill.

MaineDOT, in cooperation with a local Bridge Advisory Committee, has been investigating renewal alternatives for the Falls Bridge that include rehabilitation, replacement, or an alternate route over the Salt Pond to connect Routes 172 & 175.

The Department invites the public to hear about the alternatives and their potential impacts to archaeological, historical and environmental resources.

This meeting provides an opportunity for the public to comment on the alternatives and their potential impacts. This meeting will not identify a preferred alternative as one has not been chosen at this time.

Accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities. Auxiliary aids will be provided upon advance request.
